

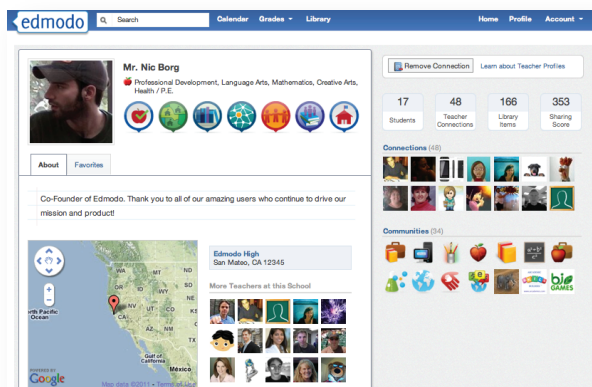
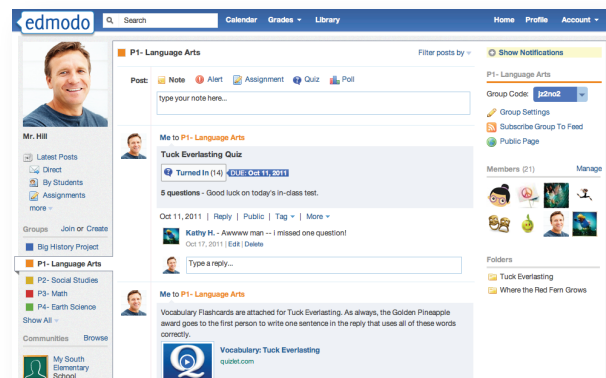

## Connect with your peers

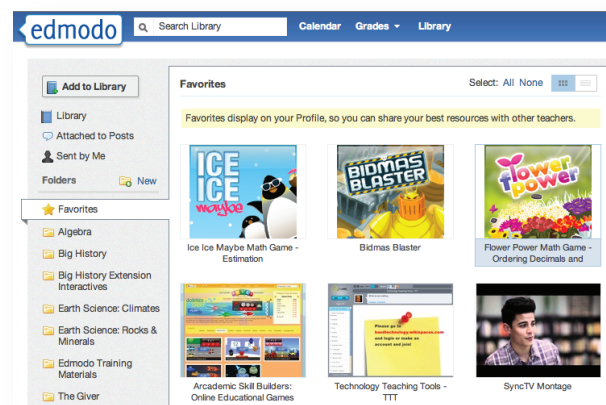
Edmodo Communities instantly connect teachers to a global network of educators.

Store and manage documents in a wide range of file formats in a cloud-based environment.

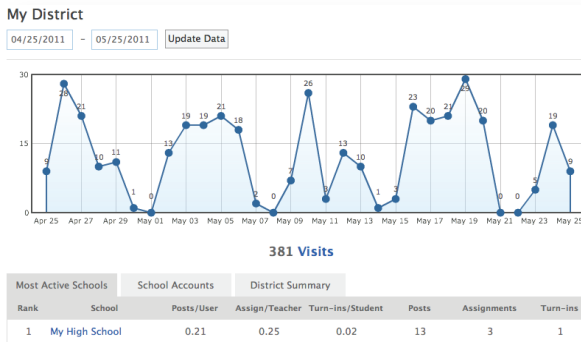
- ▶ Create and manage your personal content library, including the best content you've discovered, shared and received.

### Edmodo for your classroom

My students integrate Edmodo into their Science probe projects. I videotape short Science experiments and post to students through Edmodo. Students are instructed to stop the video at certain points and post their hypothesis in Edmodo on what may happen next.

### Edmodo for Professional Development

Joining the Edmodo Language Arts Community, I have been able to meet and connect with other teachers from around the world to share ideas and get advice. Most recently, I've collected ideas and materials for expository writing prompts, created a 'Character Corner' group for in-depth character studies of 'Bud Not Buddy', and set up a virtual poetry wall where students can share their work.

We participate in a 1:1 program at our school and Edmodo has become the central "homebase" for learning and professional development. As an administrator, I'm able to utilize the built-in analytics to monitor usage throughout all schools and report on our mobile initiatives.
